Re: Day visit to Warwick Castle, Monday 1st July 2019

I am pleased to offer your child the opportunity to go on the above day trip to Warwick Castle on Monday 1st July. This could help their understanding of the development of castles throughout the last 1,000 years from Motte & Bailey, to domestic residence, to the modern incarnation of a business enterprise. The Earl of Warwick & the castle also played a role during the Wars of The Roses as the 'King Maker' which can help with A-Level NEA preparation for the older students.

The trip is limited to 40 students in total (13 Year 12 students & 27 Year 7 students) and is on a first come first served basis. Payment is via Parent Pay. **The cost of the trip is £30pp.** Students are asked to bring a packed lunch. Those on Free School Meals need to pre-book their lunch with the canteen the week before with the aim to collect early on Monday 1st July before we leave. We are meeting at 8:15am for a 8:30 sharp departure. We aim to be back at school for normal end of lessons ie. 3:40pm.
