A message from the Headmaster, February 2020

Dear parents/guardians

First word

I hope you have followed the international adventures of QM students on twitter over the past couple of weeks. The ski trip to Italy enjoyed some fantastic weather and students made great progress in their skiing. A group of upper school students were also in Switzerland, visiting the CERN centre, amongst other science-related attractions, in Geneva. I am grateful to all staff who have led these trips.

I have communicated to parents about the implications of the ski group returning to school, following the Coronavirus concerns. As I have said, the party did not visit the area on lockdown and therefore should continue to attend school as normal, unless they develop symptoms (however mild) of a cold or flu. I appreciate the concern of parents who have contacted the school this week, but I have followed very carefully the advice of the government, Public Health England and the Public Health department of the local authority. A letter sent to schools on 27th February from Walsall council stated that:

"Public Health England and Department of Health have advised that schools do not need to close in relation to COVID 19 (even if there are associated possible cases currently undergoing testing). If a confirmed case is identified with links to a school, specific advice would be given on a case by case basis and parents and students would be updated appropriately"

In relation to the summer MEP trip to China, we continue to communicate with the Institute of Education at UCL. I will make an announcement on this next week (W/B 2nd March).

Governing board changes

The governing board met at the start of February. We paid our tributes to outgoing chair Mr Paul Lee, thanking him for all the work he has done. Mr Lee retains a link with the school as a trustee of the MAT. Mr Lee is succeeded as chair by Mr Lee Roberts. I look forward to a long working relationship with Mr Roberts.
