A quick reference guide for parents and staff (September 2021)

Child in this guidance means a student less than 18 years and 6 months, sixth-formers older than this should consult government guidance for variations in exemption rules.

- NHS Notifications must be emailed to enquiries@gmgs.walsall.sch.uk
- Following a positive PCR students are exempt from LFT/PCR testing for 90 days and MUST NOT take further tests unless they develop new symptoms during this time in which case they should be retested immediately using PCR
