### **Crime and Sexual Violence talks for Year 11**

On Monday 13th December, Anjuli Shergill, a solicitor for the Crown Prosecution Service, will be coming into school to deliver a talk to Year 11 about different types of cyber and sexual crime, to support work we are doing in PSHEE. This talk will cover definitions of a range of crimes which come under these categories and how both under-18s and over-18s can expect to be treated by the justice system both if they are perpetrators or victims.

The talk will take place in the Lecture Theatre at the following times:

Period 2: 11A & 11D

Period 3: 11P

Period 4: 11G & 11M

All students should report to the Lecture Theatre at the start of the period instead of going to their normal classroom, and the teacher they would usually have will meet and register them there.

It goes without saying that this is an extremely sensitive topic, and as a result, some pupils may feel vulnerable during the session.
