Covid-19 related pupil absence

A quick reference guide for parents and staff (17th January 2022)

Child in this guidance means a student less than 18 years and 6 months, sixth-formers older than this should consult government guidance for variations in exemption rules.

- NHS Notifications must be emailed to enquiries@qmgs.walsall.sch.uk
- Even if someone has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 90 days, they are strongly encouraged to take part in LFD testing on-site through ATS at the start of each term if Government guidelines instruct this, or twice weekly at home once they have completed their isolation period for their prior infection.
- If identified as a close contact students are strongly advised to participate in Daily Testing, in line with extant government guidance.

6.	...someone in my household tests PCR positive for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The child can still come to school if their LFT is negative - Monitor all household carefully for symptoms and continue regular LFT testing (daily for 7 days) - Contact school to inform us on enquiries@qmg.walsall.sch.uk or 01922 720696 	<p>...child can still come to school as long as their 7 day LFTs are negative</p> <p>AND the child feels well</p>
7.	...NHS test and trace has identified my child (QMGs student) as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid-19 not in the same household	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The child can still come to school if their LFT is negative - The child should follow NHS test and trace advice - Monitor carefully for symptoms and continue regular LFT testing (daily for 7 days) - Contact school to inform us if the LFT/PCR test is positive on enquiries@qmg.walsall.sch.uk or 01922 720696 	<p>...child can still come to school as long as their 7 day LFTs are negative</p> <p>AND the child feels well</p>
8.	...NHS test and trace has identified a household member (other than my child, the QMGs student) as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The child can still come to school - The household member must follow NHS test and trace instructions 	<p>...child can still come to school as long as their twice weekly LFT is negative</p> <p>AND the child feels well</p>
9.	... a sibling attending another school has been identified as a close contact of a positive case	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sibling should follow NHS test and trace advice - Child(ren) can continue to attend this setting if their LFT is negative 	<p>...child can continue to attend school as long as their twice weekly LFT is negative</p> <p>AND the child feels well</p>
10.	... my child has travelled abroad	<p>Seek guidance on the government website for the status of the country they have travelled from</p> <p>https://www.gov.uk/guidance/red-amber-and-green-list-rules-for-entering-england#green-list-rules</p>	<p>...depending on government advice (see below for new rules)</p> <p>ENSURE School has been provided with the Notification if testing required</p> <p>AND the child feels well</p>
11.	...we have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding .	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not come to school. - Contact school to inform us on enquiries@qmg.walsall.sch.uk or 01922 720696 - Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted, and shielding is paused again. 	<p>...school inform you that restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again.</p> <p>...you receive medical advice that your child may return to school.</p>

- From 04:00 GMT on Friday 7 January, people who are fully vaccinated and those aged under-18 will no longer need to take a test two days before travelling to England from countries outside the UK and the Common Travel Area. On arrival, they will have to take a PCR test but they will no longer have to self-isolate while awaiting the result
- From 04:00 GMT on Sunday 9 January they will only have to take a lateral flow test instead of a PCR test on day two. But this test must be bought from a private test provider - free NHS tests are not allowed
- Unvaccinated passengers will need to continue to take a pre-departure test, PCR tests on day two and day eight, and self-isolate for 10 days
