## Covid-19 related pupil absence

A quick reference guide for parents and staff (11th January 2022)

**Child in this guidance means a student less than 18 years and 6 months,** sixth-formers older than this should consult government guidance for variations in exemption rules.

- NHS Notifications must be emailed to enquiries@qmgs.walsall.sch.uk
- Even if someone has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 90 days, they are strongly encouraged to take part in LFD testing on-site through ATS at the start of each term if Government guidelines instruct this, or twice weekly at home once they have completed their isolation period for their prior infection.
- If identified as a close contact students are strongly advised to participate in Daily Testing, in line with extant government guidance.

- From 04:00 GMT on Friday 7 January, people who are fully vaccinated and those aged under-18 will no longer need to take a test two days before travelling to England from countries outside the UK and the Common Travel Area. On arrival, they will have to take a PCR test but they will no longer have to self-isolate while awaiting the result
- From 04:00 GMT on Sunday 9 January they will only have to take a lateral flow test instead of a PCR test on day two. But this test must be bought from a private test provider free NHS tests are not allowed
- Unvaccinated passengers will need to continue to take a pre-departure test, PCR tests on day two and day eight, and self-isolate for 10 days
