The Role:

The successful candidate will:

- Be able to teach Maths to all year groups from Year 7 to 13.
- Be at an advantage if they have experience of teaching Further Maths A-Level, or the capability to do so.
- plan and teach challenging and differentiated lessons which stretch and challenge the mathematical thinking of the students in the class
- maintain discipline in lessons to ensure that learning can take place
- deploy a range of teaching strategies to engage students
- mark students' assessments, giving constructive feedback to aid improved performance, and monitor their progress
- work alongside colleagues and students in mentoring and intervention sessions
- use relevant student data to help pupils to achieve their full potential
- communicate regularly with the Head of Department about pupil performance and achievement
- make an active contribution to the co-curricular life of the school.
- appreciate the challenges of the 'Recovery Curriculum', post-covid.

Person Specification:

- be a well-qualified Mathematics, or similar graduate
- hold, or be working towards, a Postgraduate Certificate of Education or equivalent teaching qualification in secondary education
- have genuine enthusiasm about the academic rigour of mathematics and its teaching
- be committed to diversity and representation in teaching and learning
- work as a team-player; resilient and blessed with a sense of humour
- have the ability to see the bigger picture and work accordingly
- be positive and enthusiastic in approach
- exhibit excellent oral and written communication skills
- have effective ICT skills and be willing to develop the use of ICT throughout their teaching
- commitment to support the Head of Department and the team
- be willing to be involved with and understand the importance of the pastoral life within the school and take on the role of a Form Tutor
- have a desire to become involved in the wider ethos of the school and a willingness to contribute to enrichment activities – please be aware that candidates submitting generic applications, which make scant or no reference to the school, will not be shortlisted.
