A message from the Headmaster, January 2022

First word

It is my first chance to say Happy New Year to the school community! Although the Christmas holiday seems like some time ago, I hope that it was time to rest and re-charge. It has been a busy start to term, with Year 13 mocks, Year 11 Academic Reviews and all the usual co-curricular activities that can be seen on the School's <u>Twitter account</u>. We aren't able to run the postponed Speech Day activities this week with large audiences, so are making arrangements to record the different aspects on Friday. This includes musical performances, speeches and prize giving from the academic year 2020-21, which we will make available digitally in due course.

Covid – important information

Please do continue to follow our <u>guidance</u> on reporting cases and let us know if you have any questions. In particular please note:

- LFT testing is for asymptomatic cases, a positive LFT does not require a follow-up PCR test
- All LFTs need to be registered within 24 hours on the Government <u>website</u>; you will then receive a Notification
- PCR testing is for symptomatic cases, you will receive a Notification
- Both LFT and PCR Notifications need to be emailed to enquiries@qmgs.walsall.sch.uk within 24 hours

We have updated our <u>risk assessment</u> in line with the national changes to guidance. Whilst staff and students need no longer wear face coverings in classrooms, we have been advised that they should continue to do so in communal indoor areas for the time being. I have attached a letter from the Director of Public Health with this email for your attention. Our remote learning statement is available on our <u>website</u>. This sets our expectations if students are absent from school.

English initiatives and library newsletter

Careers and work experience

If you are a parent of a Year 12 student, please do encourage them to follow up on the information given out in school about signing up for their placements.

Absences for appointments

May I remind parents/carers, as per the <u>Attendance Policy</u>, the below process for absences relating to appointments during the school day:

- Medical appointments should be arranged outside of school time wherever possible
- The school must be notified a minimum of 3 days in advance of any medical appointment that have been made. Without this prior notification the absence will be marked as unauthorised
- This notification should be sent to absences@qmgs.walsall.sch.uk with a copy of the appointment notification
- If you are attending the appointment from school you are required to collect your child from Reception and sign them out using the Exeat Book, you will need to sign them back in on their return
- If the appointment is before school you are required to accompany your child back into school and sign the Exeat Book
- Parents are not allowed to drive onto the school site, please park off site legally and with consideration for local residents
- Parents need to ensure that their child is aware of what time he/she is being collected. The student will be responsible for making their way to Reception so that they are ready for collection when you arrive to sign them out.

Home-school agreement and MS Form

We wrote to parents at the end of November, highlighting that we have made some changes to the Home-School agreement. The new document is available on the <u>school website</u>. If you haven't already done so, please complete the <u>MS form</u> as your part of this agreement.

Traffic and parking around the School

Please continue to work with us in making the school environment a safer place. In particular, please consider the following:

- Not undertaking dangerous manoeuvres (such as U-turns or overtaking) on Sutton Road or surrounding streets
- Not parking inconsiderably near to resident driveways
- Not using access roads or resident only parking areas
- Dropping the students further away from school
- Encouraging the student to use public transport
- Walking or cycling; a helmet must be worn when cycling and students should make sure they are fully visible (through lights and clothing) in the winter months
