Dear Parents

Parking & Driving around the school site

Unfortunately I find I must write to all parents to ask for your cooperation when transporting your child to school.

My Senior Leadership Team are on duty outside the school on Sutton Road at the beginning and end of each school day to keep our children safe. Regrettably that job is made difficult due to the dangerous driving and parking of a small but significant number of parents.

Similarly the school regularly receives complaints from our neighbours about inconsiderate parking preventing them from accessing their properties.

May I therefore reiterate the following points which have been made previously on several occasions:

- We encourage students to walk or cycle to school. This sustainable form of travel also promotes health. The school has secure cycle storage facilities and offers Bikeability training for students in year 7.
- We strongly encourage use of public transport. We are well served by the local bus network. West Midlands Travel offer good value termly bus passes for students which can be used for any journey, not just for school.
- If you do drive your child to school, please consider dropping/collecting them away from the school site and letting them walk the final part of the journey. This will alleviate the pressure of traffic immediately around the school.
- If parking in the local area you must follow the highway code. Parking on yellow zig-zags, in bus stops, within 10m of a junction or in front of an entrance to a property are all prohibited. Please show consideration and respect to our neighbours.
- You should not stop in flowing traffic to allow passengers to get in or out of your vehicle. My staff see this highly dangerous practice happening daily.
- Please avoid performing U-turns immediately outside the school as this frequently causes obstruction to other vehicles.

We already work with the Local Authority to promote road safety around our school. You should be aware that we proactively invite the police and parking enforcement teams to visit the school at peak times and issue penalties to drivers who are breaking the law.

I realise that the majority of parents already drive safely and considerately, but I feel I need to address the behaviour of a significant minority in order to protect the safety of all students at the school.
