I hope that you had a chance to read my letter relating to the planning permission being granted for the <u>Future</u> <u>Sport @ QMGS project</u>! This comes after over two years of hard work in fundraising, preparing plans and building our partnerships with clubs, schools and charities. We have gone out to tender and hope to appoint a contractor to carry out phases 1 and 2 (installation of the astroturf and reinstallation of the grass drainage system) in March, with work to start before the end of the academic year.

We are looking for people to give their time. We have a dedicated campaign board, made up of staff, parents and alumni. We are looking for alumni who would like to be ambassadors for the programme, organising events and advocating for Future Sport @ QMGS within their year group or community. We are looking for people to contribute financially. Thank you to those who have done so already, but, if you haven't, you can do this in a variety of ways:

Mental health and wellbeing


