A message from the Headmaster, January 2025

First word

We have been delighted to welcome a larger number of parents into school, this month, through our information events for Years 9 and 11, along with the Burns Night event last weekend. It is an important time for those making decisions on next steps and, as I said at the information evenings, I am grateful that we can work together effectively as a home-school partnership. We will be meeting the parents of Year 12 this week, for the 'Futures Evening' on Thursday, where a number of staff and students will be talking about life after QMGS. We have expanded our careers provision across the school over this year and I am pleased with how receptive the students have been to sessions and interviews held by Mr Sunley (Head of Careers) and Ms Pagett (careers advisor).

Members of Year 13 have sat their mock exams this month and, along with Year 11, the countdown is on to the public exam season in just under 15 weeks (or 100 days). The message in school has been one of organisation and a plan for this time, seeking support where needed. This is the time for the students to be honest with themselves and not leave anything to chance. Please do continue to work with us to support the students and reach out if you have any concerns.

There is lots going on in school as well as exams and options processes. The <u>Queen Mary's Observer (QMO)</u> has just been published for the autumn and this term looks to be just as busy. I hope that you had a chance to read my letter earlier in the term relating to the planning permission being granted for the <u>Future Sport @ QMGS project</u>! This comes after over two years of hard work in fundraising, preparing plans and building our partnerships with clubs, schools and charities. We will shortly be receiving tenders and hope to appoint a contractor to carry out phases 1 and 2 (installation of the astroturf and reinstallation of the grass drainage system) in March, with work to start before the end of the academic year.
